

Props Change Over:

ONE PAIR per team, Each PAIR gets 2 tries- IN ORDER

Prop Quick Change: Teams will successfully change over a props table from Thanksgiving to Christmas and back again.

Successful completion of this challenge is achieved when: Team changes over the table with high accuracy in a very short amount of time.

Each team must provide one pair of students to compete in this event. That pair can try twice; however, the second try must be completed immediately following the first. The maximum time allotted for this event is 4 minutes. ACCURACY IS OF THE UTMOST IMPORTANCE

Prior to the event, the “ONSTAGE” table should be covered with the “Scene I” tablecloth and set-up with the “Christmas” set of plates, utensils and so forth.

The “OFFSTAGE” table should be set-up with the “Thanksgiving” dishes, cloth, etc. in their Spike Lines / Areas.

Each PAIR will have 30 seconds for OFFSTAGE PROP Table preset before event starts.

1. After 30 seconds of Preset, Technicians step over STARTING LINE, **TIMING STARTS**
2. Remove SCENE 1 Props
3. Place on OFFSTAGE Table
4. Gather SCENE 2 Props
5. Place on ONSTAGE Table
6. Repeat as needed to complete Change Over.
7. Change over complete-Technicians step over STARTING LINE, **TIMING STOPS.**
8. Time is written down and penalties assessed.
Judge’s assess penalties during Change over reset
9. Technicians re-set for OFFSTAGE Table for second attempt - 60 seconds maximum.
10. After 60 seconds of re-set, Technicians step over STARTING LINE, **TIMING STARTS**
11. Change over occurs...
12. Technicians step over STARTING LINE, **TIMING STOPS**
13. Team correctly resets OFFSTAGE Table to “Thanksgiving” Spikes for next Team.
14. Time is written down and penalties assessed.

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Prop Quick Change Penalties:

Dropped prop	30 sec each
Excessive Talking or making noise during change over	15 sec
Carrying props in an “uncontrolled manner” Movement at Risk for dropping or “juggling” props	15 sec
Placing any item in the mouth or pockets	10 sec
Prop missing for specific scene	15 sec <u>per item</u>
Improper Prop position - Incorrect set-up of ONSTAGE table. Includes Silverware, Glasses, Plates, Dishes, Food, Decoration.	5 sec <u>per item</u>
Table cloth not set in proper orientation onstage– <u>Long edge should be horizontal</u>	10 sec
Table cloth not set in proper orientation onstage– <u>Short edges should be even</u>	10 sec
Not CORRECTLY resetting OFFSTAGE Table with “Thanksgiving” for next team.	3 minutes
Blatant disregard for the rules	3 minutes
